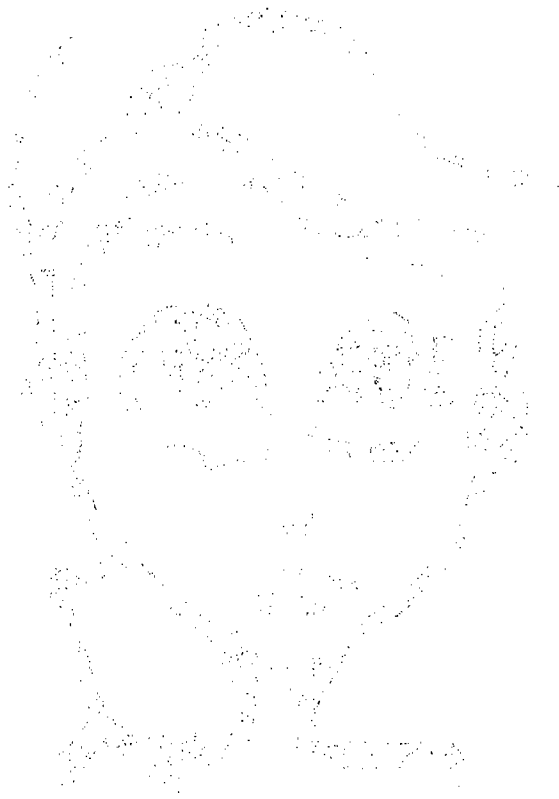

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Mathematical Induction

Mathematical induction is a method for proving that a statement is true for all natural numbers. It consists of two main steps: the base case and the inductive step.

Base Case: Prove that the statement is true for the smallest natural number, usually 1.

Inductive Step: Assume the statement is true for a natural number n . Prove that it is also true for $n+1$.

If both steps are successful, the statement is true for all natural numbers.

Mathematical induction is often used to prove properties of sequences, sums, and divisibility.

For example, to prove that the sum of the first n natural numbers is $\frac{n(n+1)}{2}$, we would use mathematical induction.

Base Case: For $n=1$, the sum is 1, and $\frac{1(1+1)}{2} = 1$. The statement is true.

Inductive Step: Assume the sum of the first n numbers is $\frac{n(n+1)}{2}$. We need to show that the sum of the first $n+1$ numbers is $\frac{(n+1)(n+2)}{2}$.

The sum of the first $n+1$ numbers is the sum of the first n numbers plus $n+1$.

Using the inductive hypothesis, we have $\frac{n(n+1)}{2} + n + 1$.

Combining terms, we get $\frac{n(n+1) + 2(n+1)}{2} = \frac{(n+1)(n+2)}{2}$.

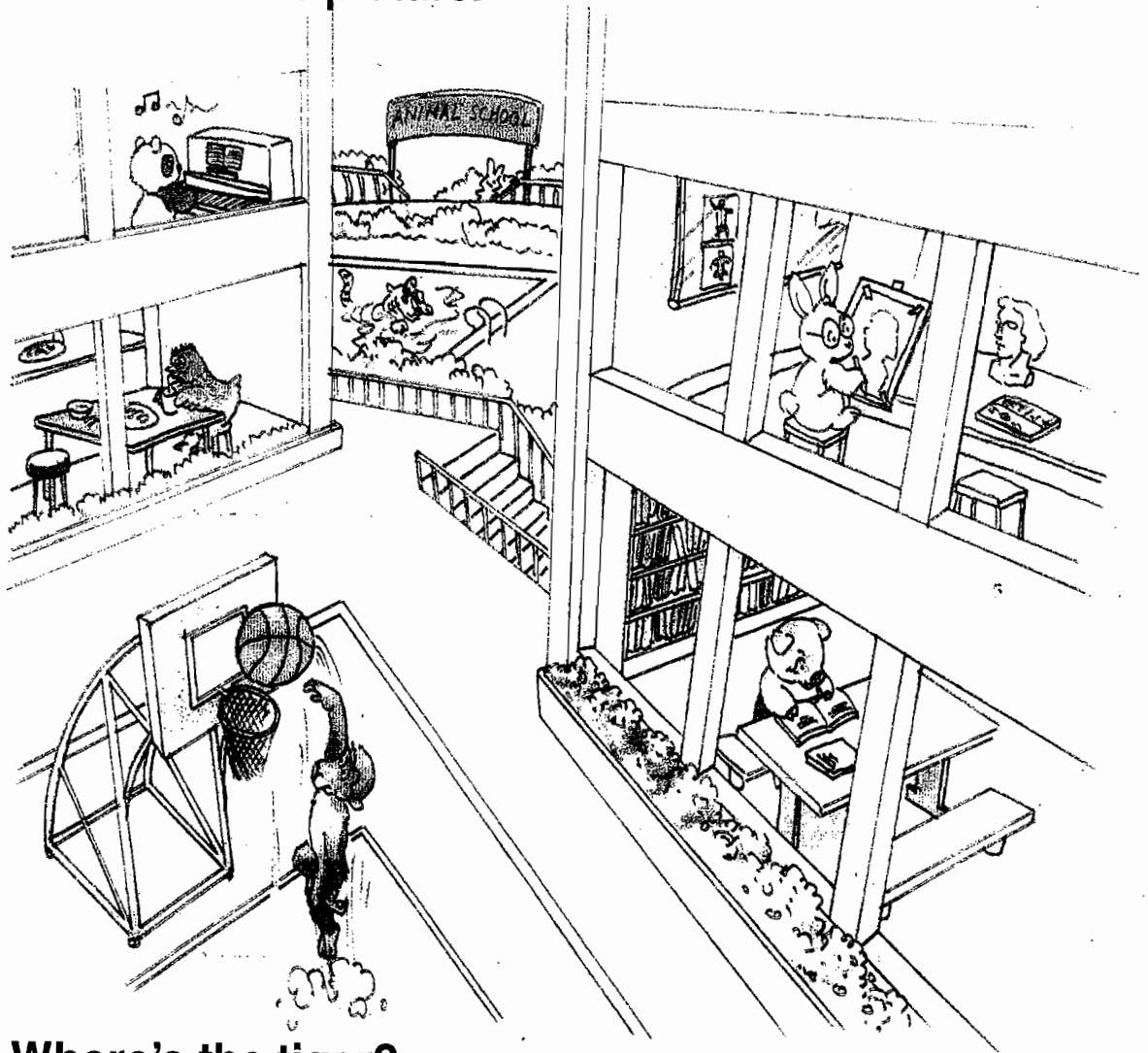
Thus, the statement is true for $n+1$. By mathematical induction, the statement is true for all natural numbers n .

Mathematical induction is a powerful tool for proving mathematical statements.

It allows us to prove that a statement is true for an infinite set of natural numbers by proving it for a few cases and showing that it holds for the next case.

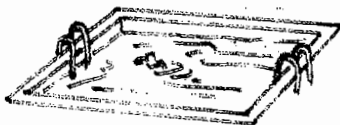
